

IN HIM Scriptures

IN CHRIST

- Rom 3:24** Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,
- Rom 6:11** Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Rom 6:23** For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Rom 8:1** There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.
- Rom 12:5** So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.
- 1 Cor 1:2** To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus called to be saints, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:
- 1 Cor 1:30** But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—
and
righteousness and sanctification and redemption—
- 1 Cor 15:22** For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.
- 2 Cor 1:21** Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God.
- 2 Cor 2:14** Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us
diffuses (manifests) the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.
- 2 Cor 3:14** But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away in Christ.
- 2 Cor 5:17** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.
- 2 Cor 5:19** That is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.
- Gal 2:4** And this occurred because of false brethren secretly brought in (who came
in by stealth to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they
might bring us into bondage)
- Gal 3:14** That the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.
- Gal 3:26** For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.
- Gal 3:27** For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.
- Gal 3:28** There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.
- Gal 5:6** For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love.
- Gal 6:15** For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but a new creation.
- Eph 1:3** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,

- Eph 1:10** That in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him.
- Eph 2:6,7** And raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.
- Eph 2:10** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.
- Eph 2:13** But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.
- Eph 3:6** That the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel,
- Phi 3:13,14** Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.
- Col 1:28** Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus.
- 1 The 4:16** For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.
- 1 The 5:18** In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
- 1 Tim 1:14** And the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.
- 2 Tim 1:9** Who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works,
but according to his own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,
- 2 Tim 1:13** Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.
- 2 Tim 2:1** You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.
- 2 Tim 2:10** Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.
- 2 Tim 3:15** And that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
- Phile 1:6** That the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.
- 2 Pet 1:8** For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus.
- IN HIM**
- Jn 1:4** In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.
- Jn 3:15,16** That whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- Acts 17:28** For in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, 'For we are also His offspring.'

2 Cor 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.

2 Cor 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Eph 1:4 Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

Eph 1:7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace,

Eph 1:11 In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,

Eph 1:13 In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,

Phil 3:9 And be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith;

Col 1:17 And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.

Col 2:6,7 As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.

Col 2:10 And you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.

Col 2:11 In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ.

1 Jn 2:5 But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him.

1 Jn 2:6 He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

1 Jn 2:8 Again, a new commandment I write to you, which thing is true in Him and in you, because the darkness is passing away, and the true light is already shining.

1 Jn 2:27 But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.

1 Jn 2:28 And now, little children, abide in Him, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming.

1 Jn 3:3 And everyone who has this hope in Him purifies himself, just as His is pure.

1 Jn 3:5 And you know that He was manifested to take away out sins, and in Him there is no sin.

1 Jn 3:6 Whoever abides in Him does not sin. Whoever sins has neither seen Him nor known Him.

1 Jn 3:24 Now he who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.

1 Jn 4:13 By this we know that we abide in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.

1 Jn 5:14 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.

1 Jn 5:20 And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us an understanding, that we may know Him who is true; and we are In Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ.

IN THE BELOVED

Eph 1:6 To the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.

IN THE LORD

Eph 5:8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light,

Eph 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.

IN WHOM

Eph 2:21 In whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord,

Eph 2:22 In whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

Eph 3:12 In whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him.

Col 1:14 In whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins,

Col 2:3 In whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

BY CHRIST

Rom 5:15 But the free gift is not like the offense. For if by one man's offense many died, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.

1 Cor 1:4 I thank my God always concerning you for the grace of God which was given to you by Christ Jesus,

Gal 2:16 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified.

Eph 1:5 Having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will.

Phil 1:11 Being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

Phil 4:19 And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

1 Pet 5:10 But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.

BY HIM

1 Cor 1:5 That you were enriched in everything by Him in all utterance and all knowledge,

Col 1:16 For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

Col 1:20 And by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.

Heb 13:15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.

BY HIMSELF

Heb 1:3 Who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

Heb 9:26 He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself.

BY HIS BLOOD

Heb 9:12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

Heb 9:14,15 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

Heb 10:19-21 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, and having a High Priest over the house of God,

1 Jn 1:7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

BY WHOM

1 Cor 8:6 Yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and by whom we live.

Gal 6:14 But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

FROM WHOM

Eph 4:16 From whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

Col 2:19 From whom all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase that is from God.

OF CHRIST

2 Cor 2:15 For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.

2 Jn 9 Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God.

He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son.

Col 2:17 Which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ.

FROM HIM

1 Jn 1:5 This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

1 Jn 2:27 But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.

THROUGH CHRIST

Rom 3:22 Even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference;

Rom 5:1,2 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Rom 5:11 And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the reconciliation.

Rom 7:4 Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you may be married to another—to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God.

1 Cor 15:57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Cor 5:18 Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,

Gal 4:7 Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Phil 4:6,7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Phil 4:13 I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

Heb 10:10 By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

Heb 13:20,21 Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

1 Pet 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

1 Pet 2:5 You also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

THROUGH HIM

- Jn 3:17** For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.
- Rom 5:9** Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.
- Rom 8:37** Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.
- Col 3:17** And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.
- Heb 7:25** Therefore His is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.
- 1 Pet 1:21** Who through Him believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.
- 1 Jn 4:9** In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him.

WITH CHRIST

- Rom 6:8** Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him,
- Gal 2:20** I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.
- Eph 2:5** Even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),
- Col 2:20** Therefore, if you died with Christ from the basic principles of the world, why, as though living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations—
- Col 3:1** If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God.
- Col 3:3** For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.

WITH HIM

- Rom 6:4** Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- Rom 6:6** Knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.
- Rom 8:32** He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?
- 2 Cor 13:4** For though He was crucified in weakness, yet He lives by the power of God. For we also are weak in Him, but we shall live with Him by the power of God toward you.
- Col 2:12,13** Buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses,
- Col 3:4** When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.
- 2 Tim 2:11,12** This is a faithful saying: For if we died with Him, we shall also live with Him. If we endure, we shall also reign with Him. If we deny Him, He also will deny us.

OF ME

Jn 6:57 As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me.

THROUGH ME

Jn 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

IN ME

Jn 6:56 He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him.

Jn 14:20 At that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

Jn 15:4,5 Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

Jn 15:7 If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

Jn 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.

IN MY LOVE

Jn 15:9 As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love.

IN HIS NAME

Mat 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.

Mk 16:17,18 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.

Jn 14:13,14 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

Jn 16:23,24 And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.

1 Cor 6:11 And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God.

These verses do not use the specific phrases In HIM, in WHOM, etc., but they convey the message of

who you are, or what you are, or what you have BECAUSE OF CHRIST.
